1. Conditions of Membership in the Regina Sailing Club

Each member is obliged to abide by club bylaws and policies which are posted in the clubhouse and on the website - www.sailregina.ca . All members are responsible for the safety and conduct of their dependants and guests. It is required that members clean up after use of club property and report property damage and any incidents to a Club Director and in the logbook. Members are required to provide "DOT approved" Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) (with whistle) for each person in their party on the water. Members may use club boats provided they have demonstrated to a designated Club Director that they meet the skill/experience requirements, and that they will adhere to Sailing Guidelines and current Club Policy. A member signing out club property is responsible for any damage to that property (eg: boat or equipment).

Disclaimer:

I understand that while sailing is usually a safe and enjoyable sport, it like all water sports can result in injury or even death. I agree to save harmless the Saskatchewan Sailing Clubs Association (SSCA), Sail Canada and the Regina Sailing Club (RSC), its organisers, respective agents, officials, servants and representatives from and against all claims, actions, costs, expenses, demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damages to me, my guests or property howsoever caused arising out of connection with taking part in events or using property howsoever caused. I further understand and agree that this release is binding upon heirs, executors, assigns and myself.

The "Business Model" for the Regina Sailing Club is based on members paying a low annual membership fee in return for volunteering to develop and maintain club infrastructure and program activity.

Club members are thus encouraged to volunteer their labour towards upkeep of the club and so more equally "share the load" - while recognizing that some members will prefer not to volunteer their labour in return for a higher annual fee. Under this system, a "Single Member" volunteering 10 hours of labour on pre-approved work projects satisfies the "club maintenance" requirement - resulting in a 100% rebate of the maintenance component. This effectively pushes back the cost of membership to 2011 levels. For other Membership Categories the "maintenance component" is similarly calculated on a pro-rated basis. 2. Guidelines for completion of the Annual Membership Fee assessment:

- (i) The Membership Application Form has two components - a **Basic Fee** & a refundable Maintenance Fee. Please complete the appropriate box(s) in the "Your Fee Calculation" column. You may choose to pay in full or pay Membership at time of application and Maintenance by cheque post-dated September 1st. You will be refunded up to 100% of the Maintenance Fee depending on recorded & approved hours of work. The threshold for 100% refund in categories "A" and "B" is 10 work hours and for category "C" is 15 hours. Refunds of less than 100% will be prorated according to hours of approved work.
- (ii) **Membership Category "D"** applies to applications after July 31st. Applicants who were full Club members in the previous 3 years are not eligible for this discount - unless previously approved by the Board of Directors (eg: due to a distant career assignment). Both the Membership Fee and the Maintenance Fee are reduced to 50% of the appropriate Category A, B or C. The reduced Maintenance fee is also 100% refundable.
- (iii) **Category "E"** applies to graduates of the current year's Sailing School. In recognition of fees already paid for the school there is a discount available of 75% of the appropriate Membership Category A, B or C and 50% in the Maintenance Fee and voluntary work requirement. (*Club member discounts also available for Sailing School*)
- (iv) **Lockers** for personal clothing and equipment are extremely limited. Please consult the Harbourmaster or another Director regarding availability.
- (v) **Late Payment Penalty:** Membership Fees are due & payable from the date of the Annual General Meeting - typically late February. Payment after June 30 will incur a late penalty fee of \$25.
